- Maintain electronic curriculum maps that are confirmed with Supervisor 2 weeks in advance of the class
- Attend as needed supervision with Supervisor for curriculum development
- Consult as needed with Program Director(s) and site supervisor for smooth continuation of psychosocial goals and strategies of all children in each class
- Set up and breakdown classroom daily
- Prepare supply list/budget
- Prepare course description
